Incorporating critical thinking and problem solving based on individual abilities among age peers keeps the gifted student engaged, functioning well, and able to maximize his/her potential contributions to self and society.

Committed to addressing the academic, intellectual, physical, social, and emotional needs of gifted students, Young-K through Grade-8, students are challenged with the next level of instruction as soon as they reach mastery of the subject matter. As a result, our average student studies math two grades above level and reading 2 to 5 grades above level. This atypically rapid pace with time for special interest studies unlocks the gifts and the joy often trapped by traditional school structures.

Supplemental coursework is offered in music/performing arts, computer programming, foreign languages, community service, and fencing. In addition to basic skills, Steppingstone provides a home for the Steppingstone MAgnetic Resonance Training (SMART) Center.

The only one of its kind, the SMART Center provides training and access to an authentic research laboratory experience with Electron Spin Resonance instrumentation plus data collection and analysis equipment normally available only to graduate students at major universities.
