

SPECIAL EVENTS (in bold and bold underlined)

Parents, we encourage you to pre-arrange your calendar and attend all special events to provide your child with the enrichment experiences and social opportunities that s/he needs for optimal development. Occasions in **bold text** are events at which attendance by all students and at least one parent is expected. **Bold underlined** events are important for both parents to attend.

COMMUNITY EVENTS/SERVICE (in red)

PROMPT ARRIVAL
