



Job Description: Live Auction Spotters

VOLUNTEER POSITION: Auction Benefit Live Auction Spotters

TIME COMMITMENT: One-time, evening of the Benefit Auction (typically 9-10pm)

DESCRIPTION: Watching for bidding paddles for Live Auction items to recognize bidders and providing information to the Auction Recorder.

GUIDELINES:

- Typically starts around 9pm the night of the Benefit Auction
- Point out bidders when bidding paddles are raised on Live Auction items
- Assist Auction Recorder to document winning bids and the Runner Up (second place) bids for each Live Auction item
- Assist Auction Recorder to document Special Purpose donors by bidder paddle number
- Collect bidder paddles once the Live Auction ends
- Give paddles to front room staff for storage
